# HEALTH SHELL SCHEME



## **WALLING**

The shell scheme raw MDF walling is 2500mm in overall height and is slotted into an aluminium frame.

Each panel size is: 970mmW x 2360mmH

## **FLOORING**

Blueberry carpet tiles.

#### **FASCIA / NAME BOARD**

An aluminum frame with a digital print fascia board installed on each open side. Each sign will be a maximum of 30 UPPERCASE characters including spaces.

The company name style is uniform and may not be altered. Words such as Company, Limited, Brothers etc will be abbreviated. No punctuation will be used.

## **LIGHTING**

 $2 \times LED$  120w track mounted spotlights per 9sqm mounted onto the light track inside the fascia. Exhibitors who opt for no fascia will receive 1  $\times$  LED Arm Light per 9sqm stand attached to the rear wall.

## DO USE ON WALLS

When attaching anything to the walls exhibitors are asked to use double sided Velcro, tape or non-toxic tack. Shelving and Slat Walling are available from ExpoNet.

## **POWER**

**No power** is included in your stand. Power can be ordered through Exponet by completing the Electric Order Form in the Online Exhibitor Manual or email <a href="mailto:esd@exponet.com.au">esd@exponet.com.au</a>

## SUPPORT PANELS

In some instances, support panels may be necessary to structurally support a stand and to comply with OH&S requirements. These panels will be either 0.5m or 1m wide dependant on the size of the wall being supported and are installed either at right angles to the back wall, or in the middle of a long length of back wall.

**No furniture** is included. Furniture can be hired through ExpoNet.
